

There are significant changes at Bey Lea Golf Course effective this year. Many of them are internal operational changes, but those that will directly affect us are summarized below. The items listed are those that pertain to our league play on Monday mornings.

First, the golf course will be closed for the months of January and February. The club house will be open weekdays only, if you want merchandise or gift cards.

Resident ID cards:

- Can be renewed starting in late February, costing \$15 this year. (Lower price)
- New Resident ID cards will be available for \$20. (Lower price)
- Replacement ID cards will cost \$5 this year... better not lose it! (New fee)

Greens Fees:

- Seniors: \$20 per rd (Increase) Non-Seniors (under 62) \$28 per rd (Increase)
- The 9-hole fees from last year are gone... all play requires 18-hole greens fee!
- DAV fees are still waived on weekdays, all fees must be paid weekends.

Carts:

18-hole cart: \$16 (Decrease) 9-hole cart: \$10

Bey Lea Rewards Cards:

Something new this year, in addition to Resident ID cards, to obtain discounts all year.

1. \$49 for a 20% off greens fees for the year (\$4 discount for seniors).
2. \$99 for a 30% off greens fees for the year (\$6 discount for seniors).
3. \$199 for a 40% off greens fees for the year (\$8 discount for seniors).

The benefit of this card is entirely dependent on the amount you play throughout the year.

Tee Time Reservations:

The \$3 reservation fee has been eliminated... however, the \$10 "No Show" fee WILL be enforced this year as an additional fee the next time you play at the course.

The reservation process remains the same via computer or over the phone.

Lockers:

Available as in past years... if interested, the fee this year is \$75 for the year.

Weekend rates are different (higher), Twilight rates are different (lower) and there is a new "Junior" player rate (\$16).

As stated above, these are things that are pertinent to our league play.

As a league, cost will be \$20 greens fees + \$16 cart fees each week (\$36 total - No change).
