TO ALL GOLF CLUB @ LAKE RIDGE MEMBERS

At our September 17th General Meeting, the Golf Club Board presented a series of proposals for the 2020 golf club season. All of the proposals were overwhelming approved by the membership.

For your information, below are listed the key items that will form the basis for the 2020 Golf Club @ Lake Ridge golfing activities - -

1. General Meetings will return to 3rd Monday of the month and will be monthly from March thru November.
2. Weekly prize fee and cash winnings will be restored to both the 9 & 18 hole leagues.
3. Weekly Closest to the Pin prizes will be added to each league.
4. Each league will consist of two (2) divisions – all league participants, whether regulars or subs will be assigned to a division, based on handicap, and remain in that division throughout the year. New GC@LR golfers will be assigned a division once they establish a handicap.
5. Regulars will pay the entire weekly prize fee in advance, subs will pay as they play.
6. Subs will be required to pay the weekly prize fee for each week they play.
7. Monthly tournaments will be conducted on Mondays from May thru October; cash prizes will be awarded.
8. There will be 13 sessions of the 18 hole league (plus rain-out dates) and 18 sessions of the 9 hole league (plus 2 9&Dine and rain-out dates).
9. A FED EX style season long competition will be added within each league/division; ONLY league sessions count; this FED EX competition will replace both the league and club championships.
10. Points will be awarded in each league/division session toward the FED EX competition. For all 18 hole players, the best 10 of 13 weekly points will count toward the FED EX championship; For all 9 hole players, the best 14 of 18 weekly points will count toward the FED EX championship.
11. The FED EX winners (one per league/division) will be named ‘GC@LR GOLFER OF THE YEAR’.
12. Since the FED EX competition is new for GC@LR, no money will be collected in 2020 for this competition and no cash prizes awarded. At the end of 2020 this competition will be reviewed and a determination made whether to continue and whether to include cash prizes.
13. GC@LR will continue to charge dues. Dues fund tournament prizes, charity donations, refreshments, administrative expenses and help keep down the fee for GC@LR events.
Dues are payable by the March General Meeting.

Specific details will be worked out by the Board over the next few weeks and presented to the membership at our final General Meeting of 2019 - - - NOVEMBER 19.
